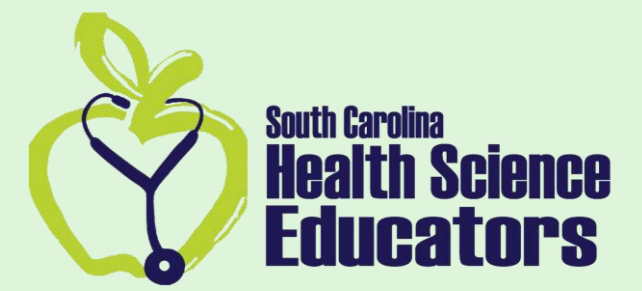
SC HSE membership lasts from the month that you join for a year until that month rolls back around next year.
